

Section 11: Gypsy / Traveller Sites in Angus.

11.1 Council Sites

The two main sites for Gypsies / Travellers in the Angus Council area are at Saint Christopher's, Tayock, Brechin Road, Montrose, and at Balmuir Wood, Tealing, by Dundee.

The Saint Christopher's site is managed by Angus Council and has a full-time Site Supervisor / Warden onsite. There are 18 stances at Saint Christopher's (10 single and 8 double) and toilet blocks and electrical connections are available for tenants to use. Rents for these stances (at April 1st 2003) are £28.30 per week for a single stance and £33.10 per week for a double stance. The site is popular, and consequently few vacancies occur. One stance was let between 28th July 2004 and 26th January 2005.

The Balmuir Wood site is managed by Dundee City Council, and information on the availability of stances, etc, can be obtained from Dundee City Council's Whitfield Office on 01382 432500, or direct from the site itself on 01382 380344 or 07951 380112.
