

Licensing Standards Officer

Angus Council employs one Licensing Standards Officer as required by the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005.

The Licensing Standards Officer's general functions and role is to:

- i) provide information and guidance to the general public concerning the operation of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 in Angus
- ii) supervise compliance of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 in all licensed premises including member clubs
- iii) provide mediation for the purpose of avoiding or resolving disputes or disagreements between licences holders and any other person raising a complaint relating to the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005

The Act also sets out in more detail the power of the LSO to deal with a breach of licence conditions by issuing a written warning to the licence holder or by making a referral to the Licensing Board for review of the licence.
