The Direct Debit Guarantee

- If an error is made by Angus Council or your Bank or Building Society, you are guaranteed a full and immediate refund from your branch of the amount paid.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by writing to your Bank or Building Society. Please also send a copy of your letter to us.

With Direct Debit, your Council Tax bill can be spread over 10 months from April. The monthly amounts are automatically deducted from your bank account on a date agreed by you. We offer a choice of dates to pay, to suit your budget.

Direct Debit takes a laid back approach to paying bills. It beats running around in circles and allows you to decide when to pay.






Simply select one of the following dates each month:-



Payment by old-fashioned methods like cash, cheque and standing order are due on the first of the month, so you can pay later by Direct Debit.
