## SINGLE OUTCOME AGREEMENT FOR ANGUS

## REPORT BY CHIEF EXECUTIVE

**ABSTRACT**

This report advises councils that the Single Outcome Agreement 2008/09 for Angus has now been agreed with the Scottish Government.

**1 RECOMMENDATION**

The council

- i note that the Single Outcome Agreement 2008/09 for Angus has now been agreed with the Scottish Government, and
- ii note the key outcomes, targets, actions, measures and indicators which Angus Council has a lead responsibility for delivering against.

**2 BACKGROUND**

The council is referred to Report No 344/08, attached as [Appendix 1](#), which was submitted to and approved by the council on 27 March 2008.

Following approval the Chief Executive entered into discussions with the Scottish Government and Community Planning Partners with a view to bringing back a agreed single outcome agreement between the council, community planning partners and the Scottish Government to the first meeting of Angus Council after the recess.

**3 SINGLE OUTCOME AGREEMENT**

The Chief Executive is pleased to inform Angus Council that following discussions with Scottish Government and Community Planning Partners the Single Outcome Agreement for Angus 2008/09 was agreed by the Scottish Government on 30 June and formally signed by John Swinney MSP on behalf of the government on 24 July 2008.
