The report incorporates, as agreed by committee in May, a corporate overview of progress against the corporate plan within 2008/09 together with an overview of performance in 2008/09 against the range of statutory performance indicators, albeit the indicators for 2008/09 remain unaudited at present.

It also includes the statement of assurance from the Chief Executive and Leader of the Council on the governance arrangements within the council in 2008/09, a statement which in previous years has been incorporated within the annual report and accounts; together with a summary of some of the actions and achievements within 2008/09 as presented in the Putting You First magazine issued to all Angus households in June.

This is the first corporate annual report and it is intended to review and develop the format over the coming year.
