TRAFFIC ORDERS

The Council hereby proposes to make **The Angus Council (Duntrune Waiting Restrictions) Order 200X** under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose of introducing 'No Waiting at any Time' restrictions in order to improve visibility and prevent obstruction at the C6 Dundee - Tealing Road/U314 Kellas Road junction in Duntrune, by Dundee.

Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft Order, which, together with a plan showing the affected roads and a Statement of the Council's Reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined during normal office hours and without payment of fee until 13 March 2009 at Reception, Angus House, Orchardbank Business Park, Forfar and the ACCESS Office, 81 High Street, Monifieth.

Any person, within 28 days from the date below, may object to the proposed Order by notice in writing to the Head of Law and Administration, Angus Council, Angus House, Orchardbank Business Park, Forfar DD8 1AN. Objections should state the name and address of the objector, the matters to which they relate and the grounds upon which they are made.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, on 9 February 2009, Angus Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1(1), 2(1) and 152(2) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, made **The Angus Council (Dundee Road, Arbroath) (Conversion of Cycle Track to Footway) Order 2009**, which comes into operation on 16 February 2009.

A copy of the order as made and of the accompanying plan may be examined during normal office hours and without payment of fee until 13 March 2009 at Reception, Angus House, Orchardbank Business Park, Forfar and Arbroath ACCESS Office, Kirk Square.

The effect of the order is as stated in Notice 1501/179 in the Edinburgh Gazette issue Number 26575 dated 9 January 2009 and, on the same date, by Notice in the Courier and Advertiser.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that, on 6 February 2009 the Council made **The Angus Council (Muir of Pert Bridge) (Temporary Prohibition of Driving) Order 2009** under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 so that bridge repair works may be undertaken.

The Order will come into force on Monday 16 February 2009 from which date it is anticipated that the work will last for a period of 5 weeks. However, the maximum duration in terms of the Act is 18 months.

The Order prohibits all vehicular traffic from driving on the C37 Hillside to Lower North Water Bridge road extending for a distance of 100 metres or thereby each side of Muir of Pert Bridge.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. There are no affected properties. The alternative route for vehicular traffic is via Montrose Old Road, Gallery Road, A937 Montrose - Marykirk Road, North Hill of Craigo Road and Montrose Old Road. The reverse route applies.

NOTICE IS FURTHER HEREBY GIVEN that, on 10 February 2009 the Council made **The Angus Council (Forfar V Glasgow Rangers Football Match) (Temporary Traffic Arrangements) No 2 Order 2009** under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purposes of accommodating the works required to facilitate the television and radio transmission of the Forfar v Glasgow Rangers football match on 18 February 2009 and to address the danger to the public arising from the volume of pedestrian and vehicular traffic on roads surrounding Station Park, Forfar on that day.

This Order is effective between the hours of 8.00am and 10.00pm on 18 February 2009.

The Order:-

- prohibits vehicular traffic from driving and waiting on
 - Carseview Road Forfar, from its junction with Market Street to its junction with Suttieside Road, and
 - John Street, Forfar, from its junction with Market Street extending in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 100 metres or thereby leading to Marketmuir (North leg of John Street over its entire length); and
- prohibits vehicular traffic from waiting on
 - the east side of Brechin Road from its junction with the B9128 at the Zoar to its junction with Market Street,
 - the north side of Market Street from its junction with Brechin Road to its junction with Suttieside Road, and
 - both east and west sides of Suttieside Road from its junction with Station Road to its junction with Carseview Road.

Pedestrian and vehicular access to affected properties will be maintained at all times.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic for 1(a) above is via Market Street and Suttieside Road. The reverse route applies. There is no alternative route for 1(b) above.
