23 August 2011	Brechin Buccaneers Junior Cricket Club	Grant requested towards the purchase of a quad bike to maintain grass cutting groundwork at Guthrie Park	<p>This club is relatively new and trying to resurrect the game of cricket in Brechin and the surrounding area by establishing a junior side that would eventually feed into the sport at senior level.</p> <p>Whilst the aim of this project is admirable, Guthrie Park is leased out to the adult cricket club and as such they have the responsibility to maintain the ground and this is not the responsibility of the junior club.</p> <p>Grant Recommended £0 on the basis that the club does not have responsibility for the upkeep and maintenance of the park area.</p>
