Administrative/Biographical history

Although a hamlet or “kirktoon” existed at Newtyle from earliest times, Newtyle is essentially a planned village, built between 1832 - 1838 to take advantage of the new railway terminus. Newtyle Village Committee was set up on 15th January 1953, with representatives of local clubs and organisations and Newtyle residents. Its purpose was to promote the welfare of the community and carry out functions assigned to it by the County Council and District Council. Among its many other activities, the Village Committee collected records associated with various local organisations to form this archive.
