

MS 620/4/45 Draft marriage contract between James Crabb & Ann Anderson

Contract of marriage Betwixt James Crabb Taylor in Montrose and Ann Anderson lawfull daughter to the deceased William Anderson in Parish of Strachan now residing in Montrose - In Case Ann Anderson should survive her husband he is to give her the half of his whole household furniture and other effects and cloths pertaining and belonging and resting and owing to him at the time of his death - And Ann Anderson is to dispone to her husband her whole effects presently belonging to her except the sum of £73 presently resting to her by Alexander Christie Esq of Rosebank for which a Bond is to be taken payable to her and her husband in liferent during their joint lives & the life of the longest liver of them, and to the said Ann Anderson her ----- Executors or assignies in -----
