NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF LOCAL PLAN

ANGUS LOCAL PLAN REVIEW

On 19 February 2009, Angus Council by resolution adopted the above named Local Plan, as modified by the Council.

Certified copies of the Plan and of the Council's resolution, together with certified copies of the Reports of all Local Inquiries held, the Council's statements prepared following the consideration of such Reports, the list of proposed Modifications, and the statement of the planning authority's decision with respect to each objection to the Modifications, containing reasons for the decision have been deposited at:

- Public Libraries in Arbroath, Brechin, Carnoustie, Edzell, Forfar, Friockheim, Kirriemuir, Letham, Monifieth, Montrose, Newtyle and the Mobile Libraries which circulate in the Angus area;
- ACCESS Offices in Arbroath, Brechin, Carnoustie, Forfar, Kirriemuir, Monifieth and Montrose;
- Planning & Transport Reception, County Buildings, Forfar; and
- Birkhill, Fowlis and Wellbank Village Halls.

The deposited documents are available for reference at the above locations, free of charge, during normal working hours and can also be viewed online at www.angus.gov.uk/localplan. A full copy of the documents is available free of charge on CD, while a hard copy of the Angus Local Plan Review is available at a cost of £30.00 (incl post and packaging).

The Plan became operational on 20 February 2009, but if any person aggrieved by the Plan desires to question its validity on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred under Part II of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997, or that any requirement of the said Part II or of any Regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the adoption of the Plan, he may within six weeks from 6 March 2009, make an application to the Court of Session under Section 238 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997.
