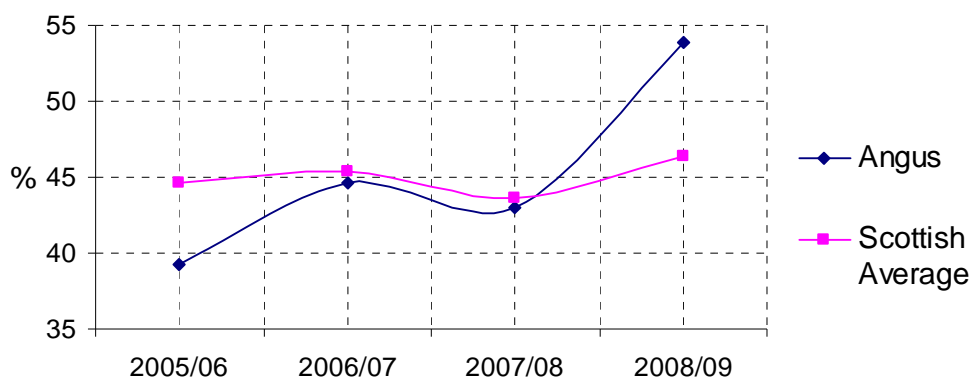

### ↑ Processing time – the percentage of householder planning applications dealt with within two months

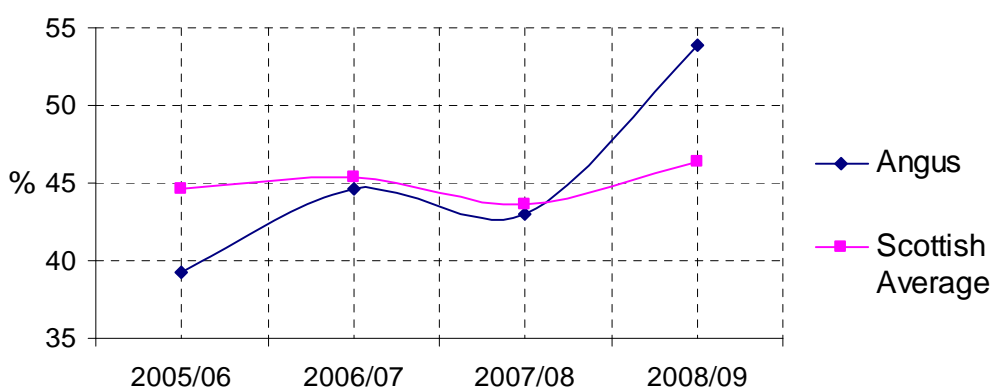
- Performance for this measure improved by 9.95% in 2008/09.

### ↑ Processing time – the percentage of non-householder planning applications dealt with within two months

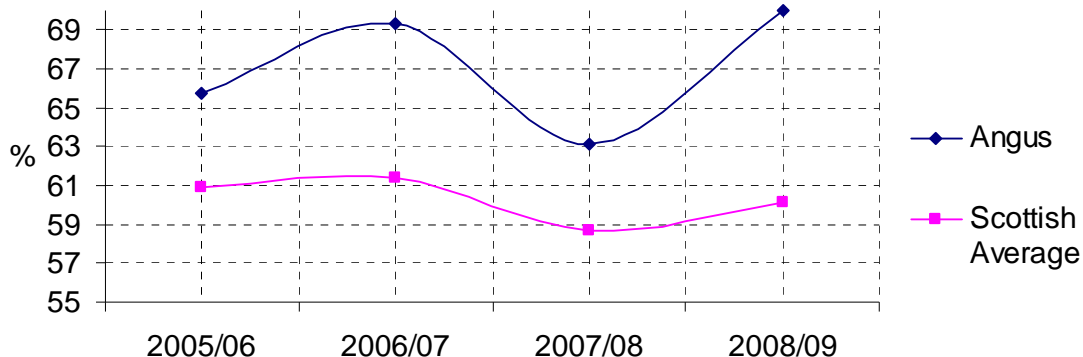
- Performance for this measure improved by 25.35% in 2008/09.

**↑ Processing time – the percentage of all planning applications dealt with within two months**

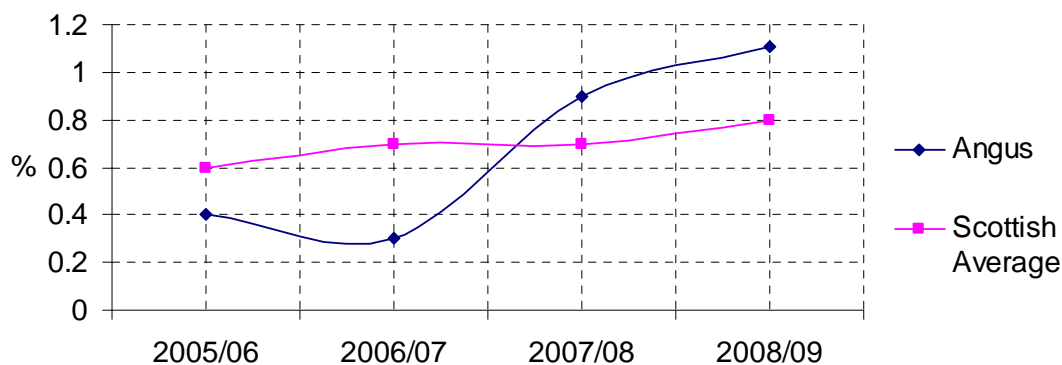
- Performance for this measure improved by 10.94% in 2008/09.

**↓ Planning Application Appeals - Successful appeals as a percentage of determinations**

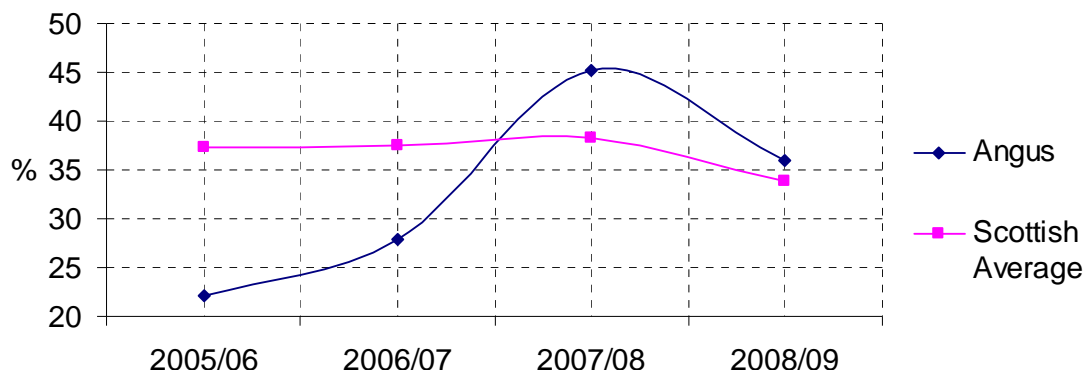
- Performance for this measure declined by 22.22% in 2008/09.
