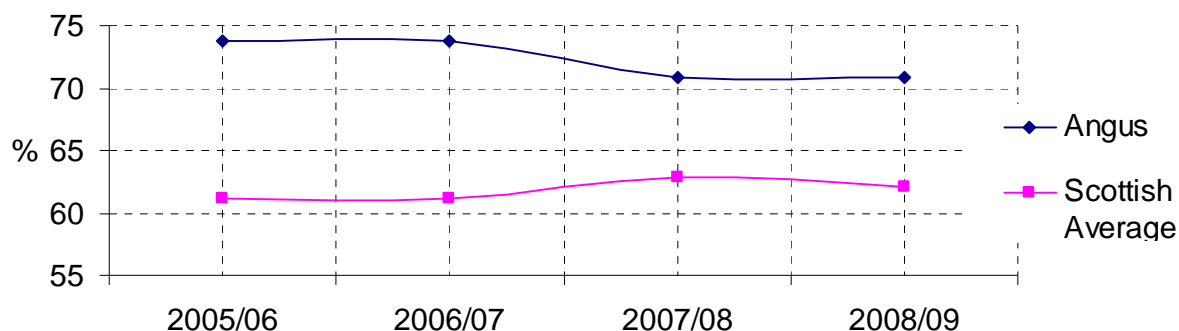

→ Percentage of primary schools in which the ratio of pupils to available places is between 61% and 100%

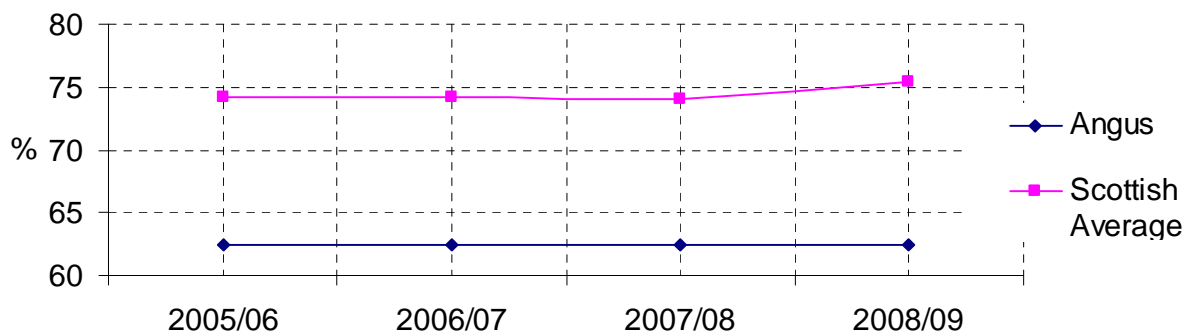

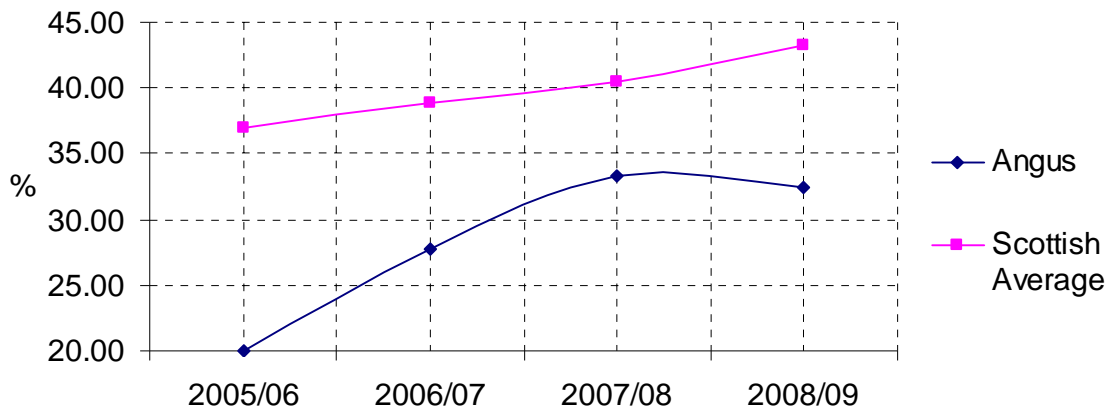

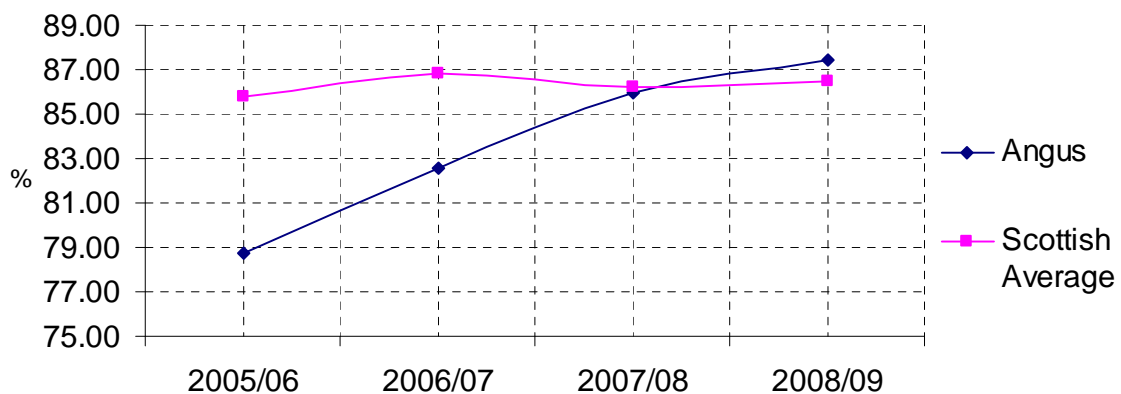

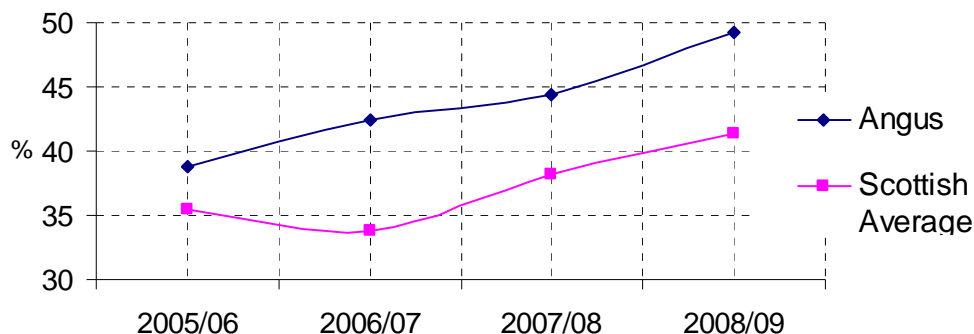

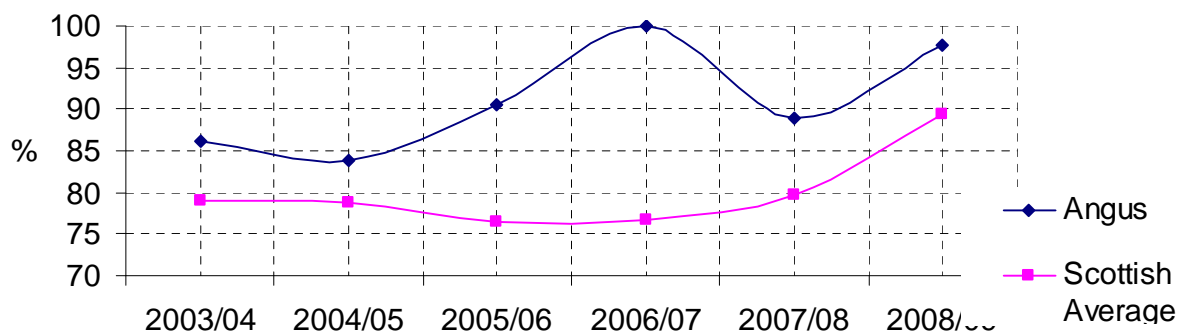

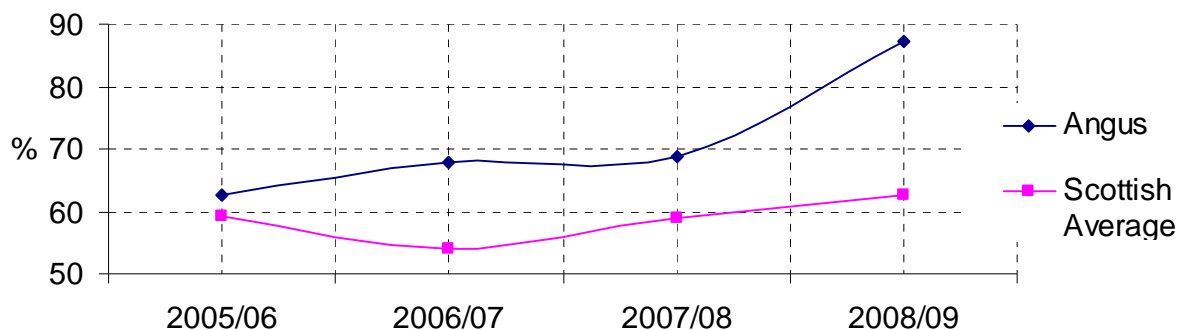

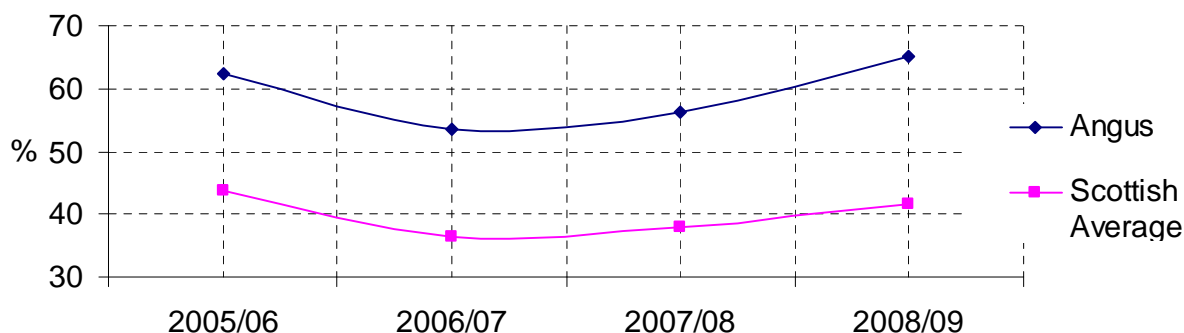

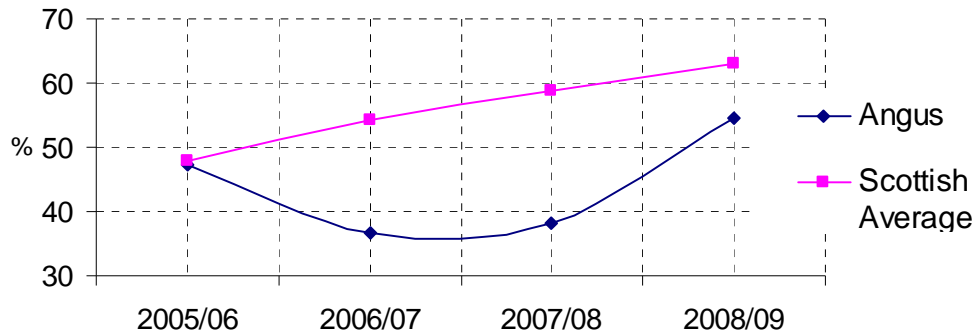

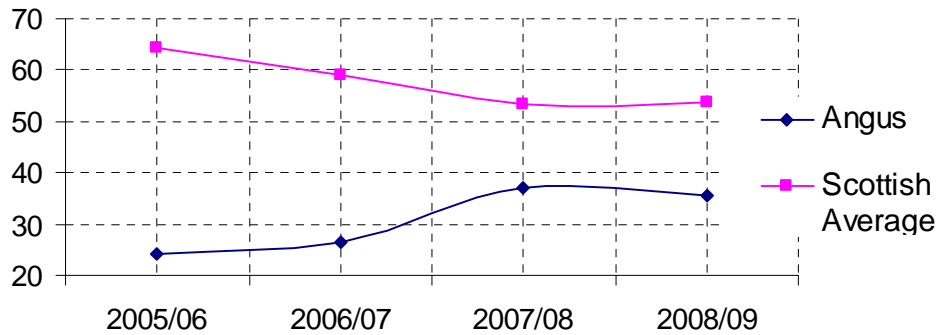

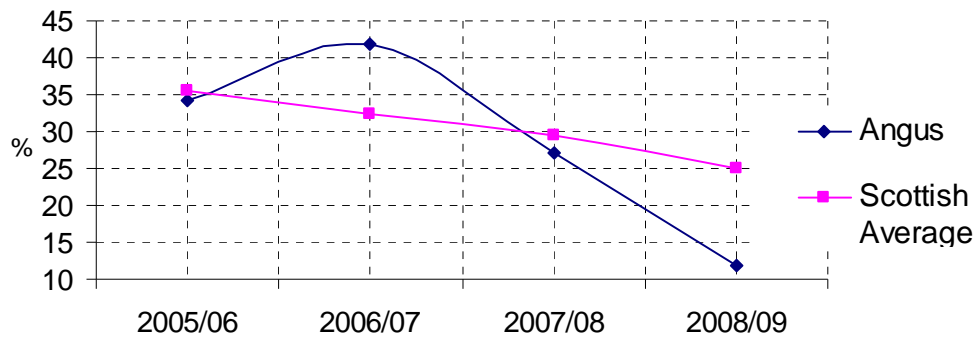

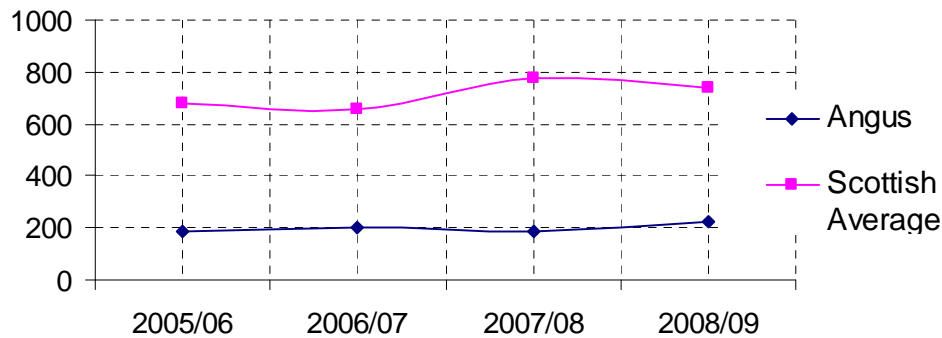

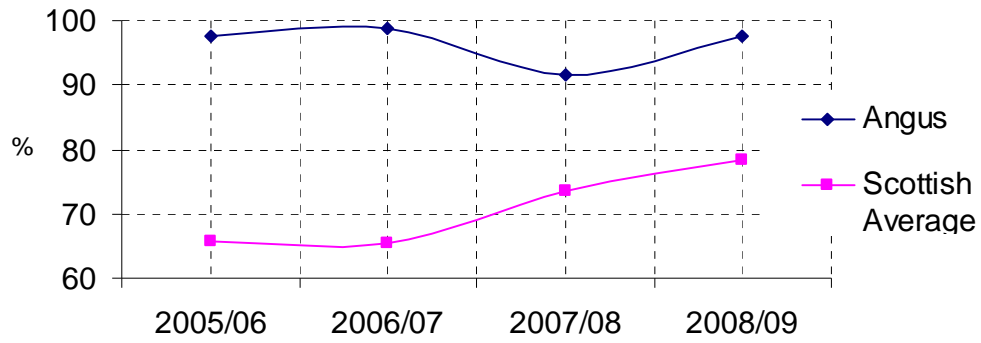
