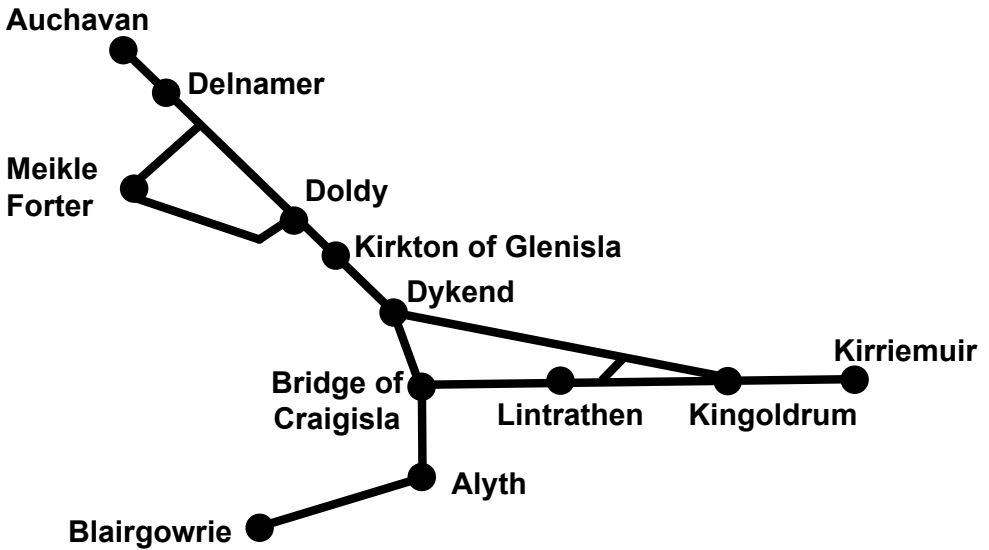

Important information about demand responsive journeys

Service 122 from Blairgowrie to Auchavan runs on a demand responsive basis; i.e. when requested to do so by intending passengers. Service 122 will also divert from the fixed route for passengers where requested and where possible to do so within a limited area.

A journey or part of a journey should be requested by phoning Angus Council's Demand Responsive Transport Hotline number on **01307 461775** between the hours of 09:00 and 15:30, Monday to Friday. Bookings can be made up to one week in advance, but to ensure your seat is booked, please call us by 15:30 the day before you intend to travel. Remember that if a journey or part of a journey is not requested, then it will not run.

Your pick-up time will be confirmed when you book your journey. Passengers are nevertheless asked to be ready at least 10 minutes before the time agreed. Whilst every effort is made to accommodate customer requests for pick-up times, calls are on a first come first served basis; your time may therefore need to be adjusted to fit into the daily travel schedule.
