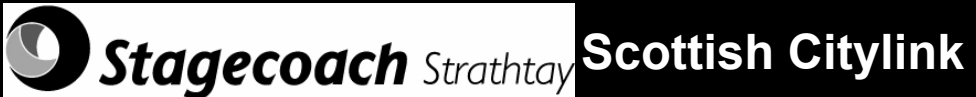
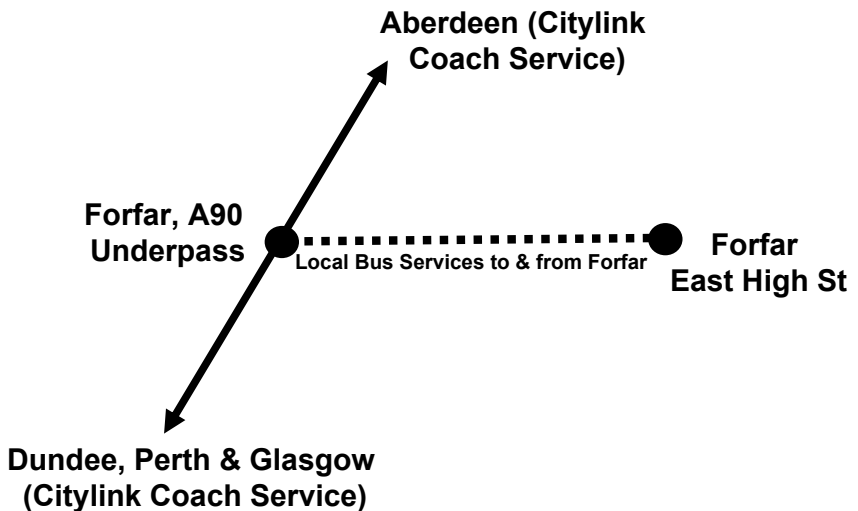

## PASSENGER INFORMATION

This leaflet contains details of Scottish Citylink journeys calling at the A90 underpass in Forfar near McDonald's where connections into Forfar are available. It is effective from 30 May 2011.

Angus Council strongly recommends that passengers pre-book their seats with Scottish Citylink. Details of how to book can be found in Scottish Citylink/Megabus publicity available from the normal outlets or online at [www.citylink.co.uk](http://www.citylink.co.uk).

A wider range of long distance journey opportunities are available from Dundee Bus Station. Passengers wishing to use these services should first travel on Stagecoach Strathtay Service 20 to Dundee Bus Station and change onto the Megabus/Citylink network there.

### Changes since the November 2010 edition of this timetable

- The connecting journeys on Service 23C to and from the Citylink bus stop at Orchardbank have been withdrawn due to minimal use. In many cases, alternative connections are available to and from Forfar Town Centre and these are shown in this leaflet. Passengers should note that waiting times between buses may have increased and that a short walk may be required to or from the Citylink stop and Glamis Road or Orchardbank Council offices.
