CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982

INDOOR SPORTS ENTERTAINMENT LICENCE

- 1. The premises are licensed for the purposes of Indoor Sports.
- 2. The licenceholder shall comply with any order or instruction given by any constable for the prevention of annoyance to the public or to the occupiers of any premises or in connection with any emergency or disturbance (including an order or instruction to close the premises for a limited period) or on any occasion when such constable in his discretion may consider it necessary in the public interest to give such an order or instruction.
- 3. The licenceholder shall not in any way alter, erase or deface the licence.
- 4. The licenceholder shall comply with or ensure compliance with such recommendations as may be made by the fire authority and the Council's technical officers and where the premises include catering facilities, the Council's environmental health officers.
- 5. The licenceholder shall ensure that :-
 - (a) all exit routes are kept free from obstruction and that exit doors are not locked or fastened to prevent them being easily and immediately opened by persons leaving the premises; and
 - (b) all equipment installed as a precaution against fire shall be maintained in efficient working order.
- 6. The licenceholder shall ensure that there are sufficient staff to supervise the running of the entertainment.
- 7. The licenceholder shall ensure that such measures as may be necessary are taken to prevent noise nuisance to residents and occupiers of premises in the vicinity.
- 8. The licenceholder, or some responsible person (not under 21 years of age) nominated for the purpose by him shall be present and in charge during the whole period of time that the public are on the premises.
