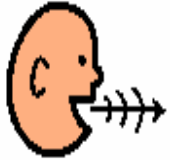




The Pre-birth Resource Allocation Meeting can help you when you are pregnant or after your baby is born.

Everyone at the meeting needs information about you and your baby's



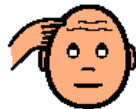
They need to share information so they can help you and your baby.

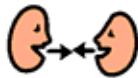

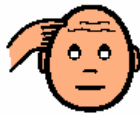
