REPORT BY HEAD OF TECHNICAL AND PROPERTY SERVICES

ABSTRACT

This report seeks approval for two property transactions which have been provisionally agreed.

The Property Transactions at **Appendix 1** will result in capital receipts of £1 and £380,000.

Appendix 1 – Open Market Disposals

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- To seek approval for the disposal of the former Swimming Pool at The Mall, Montrose. The property was advertised on the open market and one offer of £1 was received from Montrose Playhouse Project SCIO. The group had initially submitted a Community Asset Transfer request for the property although this was subsequently withdrawn. The cost demolition of the property outweighs the value of the cleared site as identified in Report No 68/13 and is the basis of the offer of £1.
- To seek approval for the disposal of the site extending to 1.42ha at Lour Road, Forfar. The site was advertised on the open market and an offer of £380,000 was received from Axil Estates Ltd. This price is on the basis of receiving planning consent for 7 houses on the site. The site was declared surplus in Report No 662/13.
