3. MINUTE OF PREVIOUS MEETING

4. LAND BETWEEN 14 TO 16 AIRLIE DRIVE, MONIFIETH

There was submitted Report No 474/14 by the Head of Legal and Democratic Services, detailing an application for a review of the decision by the Planning Authority in respect of the refusal of planning permission in principle for the proposed housing at Land between 14 and 16 Airlie Drive, Monifieth.

The Committee gave careful consideration to the papers submitted by the appointed person and by the applicant and determined that they had sufficient information to consider the review at this meeting.

Following discussion, the Committee agreed that the decision to refuse the application was in accordance with the Council's Local Plan Policy. The Service Manager's (Planning) decision was endorsed and accordingly the review dismissed.
