### **REMOVAL/RELOCATION EXPENSES FOR TEACHERS**

#### REPORT BY SHARON FAULKNER, HEAD OF HR, IT & ORGANISATIONAL DEVELOPMENT

#### ABSTRACT

This report seeks agreement to extend the council's existing policy on the provision of removal/relocation expenses to include teachers.

#### 1. RECOMMENDATION(S)

It is recommended that the Policy & Resources Committee:

(i) agree that the council's Assisted Removal/Relocation Scheme be extended to include teachers and associated professionals.

# 2. ALIGNMENT TO THE ANGUS COMMUNITY PLAN/SINGLE OUTCOME AGREEMENT/COPORATE PLAN

This report contributes to the following local outcome(s) contained within the Angus Community Plan and Single Outcome Agreement 2013-2016:

- Angus is a good place to live in, work in and visit
- Our children and young people are confident individuals, effective contributors, successful learners and responsible citizens
- Adults maximise their potential through learning opportunities.

## 3. BACKGROUND

Report 205/16 to the Children and Learning Committee of 17 May 2016 summarised action taken to consider the possibility of developing an 'Angus Offer' consisting of a range of attractive options aimed at encouraging teachers to work in Angus. This included a number of incentives for attracting new teachers to Angus, one of which was the provision of removal/relocation expenses.

## 4. CURRENT POSITION

The council currently has an Assisted Removal/Relocation Scheme. Access to this is limited to all employees who are employed under the JNC Scheme for Chief Officials and Deputes or the SJC Scheme for Local Government Employees.

## 5. PROPOSALS

It is proposed that this Scheme be extended to include the provision of relocation expenses to those employed under the SNCT Scheme for teachers and associated professionals. A copy of the amended Scheme is attached for approval.

#### 6. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

It is anticipated that any costs in relation to the provision of relocation expenses will be met from within existing budgets.
