Thank you for your letter dated 28 June 2016.

Having considered the responses received, at this stage we do not feel it necessary to provide further comment. Each comment submitted by objectors has been considered thoroughly throughout the planning process, and it is the Appellants opinion that the issues raised by the objectors have been dealt with comprehensively within the Environmental Assessments and the Appeal Statement of Case.

The design of the development has considered the impact on the nearest residents as priority. As explained within the Appeal Statement of Case, the turbine selected is of the smallest scale possible in order to ensure that the development is efficient and viable, but also keeps impact on residents to a minimum.

It is the opinion of the Appellant that the development strikes the balance of being an appropriate scale within the setting of a busy industrial estate and ensuring that no significant adverse impacts would occur. Furthermore, the benefits of safeguarding an important local employer and the opportunity to grow the business on the back of this sustainable development are considered fundamental to the maltings future and should be given substantial weight.
