## CONSULTATION ON PROPOSAL FOR A CYBER RESILIENCE STRATEGY FOR SCOTLAND

## 1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 In June 2015 the Scottish Government published its 'Consultation on proposal for a Cyber Resilience Strategy for Scotland' with a response deadline of 28 August 2015.
- 1.2 The consultation seeks to take forward the Scottish Government's "commitment to building cyber resilience amongst our communities, our businesses and our public services." The consultation seeks views from individuals and organisations, across sectors, on how Scotland can become even more resilient from cyber attacks and crime when using online technologies.
- 1.3. Officers across Angus Council collaborated to develop a single co-ordinated response to the consultation. A copy of the response submitted on behalf of Angus Council is attached as Appendix 1 to this Schedule.
- 1.4 Following the closing date, all responses will be analysed and considered along with any other available evidence to help the Scottish Government reach a decision on the questions contained in the consultation. They will analyse responses to support the further development of the strategy, which they aim to publish in November 2015.
- 1.5 Responses to the consultation, including Angus Council's response, will be made available to the public in the Scottish Government Library and on the Scottish Government consultation web pages by 18 September 2015.
