ANGUS COUNCIL COMMUNITY GRANT SCHEME

REPORT BY CHIEF EXECUTIVE

ABSTRACT

This Report informs the Policy and Resources Committee of applications to Angus Council in 2016/17 of £1,000 or less submitted and/or approved since 29 November 2017. It also seeks approval of grant applications of over £1,000 recommended for approval since 29 November 2016.

7. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

7.1 Angus Council Community Grant Scheme - 2016/17

The base provision for the Angus Council Community Grant Scheme contained within the 2016/17 revenue budget totals £58,000 comprising Communities - £7,000 and Other Services revenue budget - £51,000. Included in this amount from is a ring-fenced amount of £15,000 available for Innovation, Architecture and Design projects in support of the Scottish Government Focus Years programme as outlined in report 110/15.7.2. There was a refund of £236 repaid by Montrose Playhouse Project (project ref 1415.003), bringing the total funding available for 2016/17 of £58,236.

- 7.2 A previous grant award of £3,420.00 for Mofest (project ref 1617.049) has been unsuccessful in receiving match funding and an updated request has been submitted for approval in this report. The original grant amount of £3,420.00 has been added to the Community Grant Scheme Budget for 2016/17. This would reduce the previously reported grant awards of £51,921.07 to £48,501.07.
- 7.3 The amount submitted for approval in this Report for 2016/17 totals £9,482.40, (£1,000.00 and £8,482.40), a total grant award for 2016/17 of £57,983.47.
- 7.4 The combined total of grants awards for 2016/17 is £57,983.47 leaving a total uncommitted balance of £252.53 available to fund grant applications for the remainder of 2016/17.
