(ii) LOCAL PENSION BOARD

The Public Service Pensions Act (PSPA) 2013 introduces a number of changes to public service pension schemes, including governance changes. One of the key changes is the requirement for each Administering Authority in the Local Government Pension Scheme (LGPS) to create a local Pension Board to be in place by 1st April 2015. For the Tayside Pension Fund this means establishing a Pension Board that will have the responsibility for assisting Dundee City Council as Scheme Manager in securing compliance with requirements imposed by the Pensions Regulator and the scheme regulations or other legislation relating to the governance and administration of the LGPS

A nomination is required from Angus Council to be one of 4 employer representatives on the Pensions Board. The nominee must undertake a training programme in accordance with guidance issued by the Pensions Regulator and comply with best practice training requirements of the Pensions Sub-Committee.

The Council is also asked to nominate a named substitute. Nominees would serve a five year term (subject to any changes arising because of local government elections).
