2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

The Committee agreed to note that no declarations of interest were made.

3. MINUTE OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The minute of meeting of this Committee held on 6 August 2015 was approved as a correct record and signed by the Convener.

4. DELEGATED APPROVALS

5. CORBIE KNOWE, LUNAN BAY, INVERKEILOR – CARAVAN SITE LICENCE

There was submitted Report No 358/15 by the Strategic Director – Communities regarding an application for a caravan site licence in terms of the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act 1960 from Robina Hunter, 54 Shiel Avenue, East Kilbride in respect of the site located at Corbie Knowe, Lunan Bay, Inverkeilor.

The Committee agreed:-

- to grant a caravan site licence to Robina Hunter, 54 Shiel Avenue, East Kilbride subject to the site's compliance with the "Model Standards" for caravan sites and the drinking water being supplied via the provision of bottled water;
- (ii) that the maximum number of caravans to be stationed on site at any one time be 15; and
- (iii) that the operating period be 1 January to 31 December.
