# **WOODLANDS CARAVAN PARK, CARNOUSTIE**

## REPORT BY THE HEAD OF HOUSING, REGULATORY & PROTECTIVE SERVICES

### **ABSTRACT**

This report deals with an application to add a static caravan to the existing caravan site licence at Woodlands Caravan Park, Carnoustie for sole use by the site manager/warden whilst the site is open for business.

# 1. RECOMMENDATION(S)

- 1.1 It is recommended that the Committee agree:
  - that the caravan site licence be amended in order to allow one static caravan to be added to the site licence.

### 3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 Application has been made to Angus Council by Mr William Fergusson, Shotburn House East, Windygates Road, Leven to site an additional static caravan at Woodlands Caravan Park, Newton Road, Carnoustie. The site is a touring caravan site and the addition of a static caravan is to accommodate the manager/warden of the site during the spring/summer season. There are no proposed changes to the number of tourers (currently 43) or to the operating period of the site (currently 1 March to 31 October each year).
- 3.2 The site operates with the benefit of appropriate planning permission and it is confirmed that the above amendments would not result in any breach of the current planning consent.
- 3.3 A recent site inspection confirmed that the site complies with licence conditions and meets the "Model Standards" under the Caravan Site and Control of Development Act, 1960.

## 4. DETERMINATION OF LICENCE

4.1 On the basis that the site meets the requirements of "Model Standards" in compliance with The Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act, 1960 and that the necessary planning consents are in place, this application to amend the licence should be granted.
