DELEGATED APPROVALS – CONFIRMATION OF PROVISIONAL PREMISES LICENCES

ABSTRACT

The purpose of this report is to advise members of applications for confirmation of provisional premises licences under the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 which have been granted by the Clerk in accordance with the Scheme of Delegation appended to the Boards Statement of Licensing Policy.

1. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board note the applications for confirmation of provisional premises licences granted under delegated authority as detailed in the attached Appendix.

2. BACKGROUND

In terms of the Scheme of Delegation appended to the Boards Statement of Licensing Policy, the Clerk to the Board is authorised to grant any application for confirmation of a provisional premises licence where no variation (other than a minor variation) has been made to the operating plan or layout plan for the premises to which the licence relates since the provisional licence was issued or since a variation of the provisional premises licence was granted.
