VANDALISM REPORT

BACKGROUND

As part of the mind mapping exercise carried out by members of the Pride In Place Member Officer Group, it was thought that the act of vandalism caused by graffiti may be an impact on our towns within Angus.

An analytical report on the above topic has been produced and is attached. The findings show that in the 9 month period across Angus there have only been 15 reported incidents of vandalism which equates to 2% of all recorded vandalism by the police.

The report is self-explanatory outlining the profile of type of vandalism, the times and locations of such crimes and the likely profile of perpetrator.

The report covers the period from 1 April 2014 to 31 December 2014.
