KEPTIE ROAD, ARBROATH**

I refer to your e-mail dated 25 July 2017 in connection with the new grant of a Street Trading Licence from the above applicant and would offer the following objection to the application for the siting of a burger van on Keptie Road.

The site proposed for the burger van is within a lay-by on a busy street which has a high demand for on-street parking from both residents and students attending the nearby Angus College. The width of the carriageway in the lay-by would be reduced by the siting of the burger van and could lead to access issues for service and emergency vehicles. Footfall on the adjacent footway can also be high at certain times of the day and any customers queuing at the burger van may impede pedestrian movements, forcing them onto the carriageway.
