3. NEW CONTROL MEASURES AT RECYCLING CENTRES

Re- Submit Report No 357/17 by the Head of Housing, Regulatory and Protective Services

Members are referred to the decision of Angus Council on 19th October 2017 to defer that part of Report No 357/17 relating to the use of trailers in the following recycling centres:-

Brechin,
Carnoustie,
Forfar and
Monifieth

Officer advice has now been received and on that basis it is proposed that trailers in excess of 6ft bed length are prohibited from the above noted centres.

NOTE: The decisions agreed on 19th October in relation to Kirriemuir when it was agreed to ban all trailers; in relation to Montrose and Arbroath, where no prohibition was imposed and the amendment agreed in relation to evening opening times across all centres, **remain unaffected.**

(i) ANGUS HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE INTEGRATION JOINT BOARD
