**CORPORATE RISK REGISTER UPDATE**

**ABSTRACT**

This report presents an update on the work being done with the Corporate Risk Register.

**1. RECOMMENDATION**

**2. ALIGNMENT TO THE LOCAL OUTCOMES IMPROVEMENT PLAN (LOIP) AND COUNCIL**

The proposals set out in this report will contribute to the outcomes outlined in the proposed Local Outcomes Improvement Plan, Locality Plans and Council Plan, which focus on the economy, people and place.

**3. BACKGROUND**

Reference is made to report 324/17 presented to this Committee on 26 September 2017. It noted that given the new organisational structure a major evaluation of the existing corporate risks was to be carried out and reported to this meeting.

**4. CURRENT POSITION**

The council's EMT reviewed all existing corporate risks at its meeting on the 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2017. This was the first date available given competing priorities, full agendas and planned annual leave.

Each risk was examined to verify its relevance, appropriateness, likelihood and impact. A summary of the work undertaken to date is noted in Appendix 1.

There is still work to be done to conclude the review; some risk definitions need to be corroborated and associated actions require to be updated accordingly.

A copy of the full current corporate risk register is attached in Appendix 2.

A report will be submitted to the next meeting of this committee on 23 January 2018 detailing the further work undertaken.
