EDUCATION PLAN MID-TERM UPDATE

BACKGROUND

The Angus Annual Education Plan was subject to committee approval in August 2017, as outlined in report 271/17. The attached performance monitoring summary highlights the progress made with the actions set out in this plan as a mid-session review.

In addition to the improvement actions set out in the Plan, last term saw the successful delivery of the Angus Children and Learning Festival.
