There are currently two mainstream day care facilities in Arbroath; following the implementation of SDS and the contribution policy both facilities have had a decline in the number of referrals. Seaton Grove day care costs £52.41 per day and there are 24 designated places with 5 vacancies and the Town Mission costs £30.04 per day and has 80 designated places with 20 vacancies. The decline in referrals to the Town Mission is unsustainable for the future and there is a risk of closure.
