ANGUS COUNCIL (THE OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP, CARNOUSTIE) EXEMPTION ORDER 2018

Angus Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11(1) of the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003 ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, having consulted with Angus Local Access Forum and other persons they consider appropriate, having given public notice of the intended purpose and effect of the Order, and having considered any objections and representations made to them, all in accordance with Section 11(2) of the Act, hereby make the following order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the "Angus Council (The Open Championship, Carnoustie) (Exemption) Order 2018" ("the Order") and shall come into effect at 00.00 hours 19 March 2018 and will expire on 23.59 hours on 31 August 2018, unless revoked earlier.
- 2. In the Order "the Event" means The Open Championship, Carnoustie 2018.
- 3. The effect of the Order is to exempt:
 - between 19 March 2018 and 31 August 2018 inclusive, Area A comprising the area adjacent to the golf course practice area including part of core path 170 shown outlined and hatched red and titled "A" on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the Plan")
 - (ii) between 7 May 2018 and 31 August 2018 inclusive, Area B comprising the area to the South and East of Carnoustie Links Hotel including the golf centre, black slab car park, tennis courts, sailing club compound, adjacent grassed areas and part of core paths 167, 168 and 170 respectively shown outlined and hatched red and titled "B" on the Plan
 - (iii) between 2 July 2018 and 6 August 2018 inclusive, Area C comprising the remainder of Carnoustie Golf Links including core path 170 and core path 169/National Cycle Route 1 shown outlined and hatched blue and titled "C" on the Plan

from the access rights which would otherwise be exercisable in respect of that land by virtue of Part 1 of the Act.

- 4. The purpose(s) for which the Order is made are:-
 - (a) to facilitate the establishment of a site compound area for safety reasons;
 - (b) to provide safety during the construction of the Championship Village;
 - (c) to protect the safety and security of the event; and
 - (d) to allow a charge for admission to the event.
