## 2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

The Board agreed to note that no declarations of interest were made.

## 3. REVIEW OF PREMISES LICENCES.

With reference to Article 8 of the minute of meeting of this Board of 4 January 2018, there was submitted Report No LB13/18 by the Clerk presenting four Premises Licences under the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 ("the 2005 Act") which the Board required to review as detailed in Appendix 1 to the Report.

The Board noted that the Annual Fees had now been paid for The Old Bolag Bar, 1 Church Street, Brechin and The Wellbank shop, 13 Kellas Road, Wellbank, however, despite the Clerk giving notification to the licensee's that the annual fees were now overdue the fees remained unpaid in respect of the premises Club One, 89 – 91 North Street, Forfar and Azzurro Ristorante, 43 High Street, Arbroath.

### (a) Club One, 89 – 91 North Street, Forfar

There was submitted a report from the Licensing Standards Officer in respect of the premises at Club One, 89 - 91 North Street, Forfar.

The Board noted that the annual fee of £280 was still outstanding and agreed to revoke the licence with immediate effect. The outstanding fees to be pursued by the Clerk.

### (b) Azzurro Ristorante, 43 High Street, Arbroath

There was submitted a report from the Licensing Standards Officer in respect of the premises at Azzurro Ristorante, 43 High Street, Arbroath.

The Board noted that the annual fee of £220 was still outstanding and agreed to revoke the licence with immediate effect. The outstanding fees to be pursued by the Clerk.
