

# ANGUS HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE INTEGRATION JOINT BOARD – 18 APRIL 2018 PERFORMANCE – DELAYED DISCHARGE REPORT REPORT BY VICKY IRONS, CHIEF OFFICER

## **ABSTRACT**
