3. MONIFIETH CLUSTER SCHOOLS OPTIONS APPRAISAL

With reference to Article 12 of the minute of meeting of the Children & Learning Committee held earlier today, there was submitted Report No 130/18 by the Strategic Director – People presenting the proposed options to engage with children, young people, families, staff and citizens about Monifieth High School and all primary schools within the Monifieth cluster including the provision of leisure facilities.
