INTRODUCTION OF OFF-STREET PARKING CHARGES

On 8 October 2018 Angus Council made the Angus Council (Off-Street Car Parks) (Decriminalised Enforcement) (Variation) (No. 2) Order 2018. The order introduces parking charges in specified off-street car parks in Angus and comes into operation on 1 November 2018.

Notice of the proposal to introduce charges was published in the Courier and Advertiser on 3 August 2018 and the effect of the order is as described in that notice.
