**ANGUS COUNCIL (WEIGHT LIMITS ON BRIDGES) ORDER 2003**

Angus Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 1(i) and (2), 2(i) to (3) and 4(i) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "Angus Council (Weight Limits on Bridges) Order 2003" and shall come into operation on the Fifth day of December Two thousand and Three.
2. The Tayside Regional Council (Weight Limits on Bridges) (Consolidation) Order 1987 is hereby revoked insofar as it refers to any bridge situated within Angus.
3. No person may drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle or vehicle and load upon any length of road carried by a bridge specified in Column 1 of the Schedule if the weight of the vehicle or vehicle and load combined exceeds the weight specified in Column 2 of the said Schedule opposite to the description of the said length of road carried by the said Bridge.
