3. NEW APPLICATION – RESIDENTIAL CARAVAN SITE – MONARCH OF THE GLEN PARK, BRECHIN ROAD, MONTROSE.

There was submitted Report No 144/19 by the Service Leader – Legal and Democratic Services regarding an application received for a residential caravan site licence from Torryburn Investments Ltd in respect of the Monarch of the Glen Park, Brechin Road, Montrose, as detailed in the Report and shown on the site plan in Appendix 1 to the Report.

Mr Spence, the applicant was present and addressed the Committee during which he advised members that he intended to repair the box housing the electrical consumer unit for the communal lighting and gate circuits.
