**NOTICE OF MAKING THE ANGUS COUNCIL (OFF-STREET CAR PARKS)
(DECRIMINALISED ENFORCEMENT) (VARIATION) (NO. 3) ORDER 2019**

On 1 July 2019, Angus Council made the Angus Council (Off-Street Car Parks) (Decriminalised Enforcement) (Variation) (No. 3) Order 2019 (the "Order") which comes into operation on 8 July 2019.

Notice of the proposal to make the Order was published in the Courier and Advertiser on 7 June 2019 and the effect of the Order is as described in that notice.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred on Angus Council by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that a requirement of that Act or of any relevant regulations made under that Act has not been complied with may make application for this purpose to the Court of Session by 12 August 2019.
