

**The Angus Council (RAF Freedom of Angus Parade at Montrose)
(Temporary Traffic Restrictions) Order 2019**

Notice is hereby given that on Friday 12 July 2019 Angus Council made an Order under Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.

This Order is effective on Friday 26 July 2019 between the hours of 9.30am and 3.00pm for the purpose of minimising danger to the public attending or participating in the above event.

The Order will:-

- (1) prohibit the waiting of vehicles, between 9.30am and 4.00pm, on the following roads in Montrose:-
 - **High Street** from its junction with George Street northwards to a point 45 metres north of Hume Street;
 - **Castle Place** for its entire length;
 - **George Street** between High Street and Baltic Street and
 - **Baltic Street** between George Street and Museum Street.
- (2) prohibit the driving of vehicles, between 10.30am and 4.00pm, on **Baltic Street Montrose** between its junctions with George Street and Museum Street.

The alternative route for vehicles is via George Street/Panmure Place/Museum Street. The reverse route applies.

- (3) prohibit the driving of vehicles between 1.45pm and 4.00pm on the following roads in Montrose:-
 - **High Street** between its junctions with George Street and New Wynd;
 - **George Street** between High Street and Baltic Street.

The restrictions at (3) above will be implemented on the basis of a "rolling" road closure with "points" traffic control at junctions along the route controlled by Police Officers in uniform, as they consider necessary. Local diversion signing for vehicles will be provided as necessary.

Pedestrian access and access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
