MINUTE of MEETING of the **SPECIAL CIVIC LICENSING COMMITTEE** held in Training Room C, Angus House, Forfar on Monday 22 July 2019 at 1.30pm.

1. APOLOGIES

2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

The Committee agreed to note that no declarations of interest were made.

3. TEMPORARY CARAVAN SITE LICENCE - GLAMIS CASTLE PARK SHOWFIELD, GLAMIS

There was submitted Report No 174/19 by the Director of Communities regarding an application received for a temporary caravan site licence in terms of the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act 1960 from Mr James Helyer, Park House, Auchlishie Farm, Kirriemuir DD8 4LS in respect of land located at Glamis Castle Park Showfield, Glamis as set out in Appendix 1 to the Report.

The Report advised that the land which the application related to would be used between 1 and 4 August 2019 to allow traders attending the Glamis Country Fair & Horse Trials event to site their caravans.

The Committee agreed:-

- (i) to grant a caravan site licence to James Helyer, Park House, Auchlishie Farm, Kirriemuir DD8 4LS for a site located at Glamis Castle Park Showfield, Glamis as detailed in the Appendix to the Report, subject to the site's compliance with the "Model Standards" for caravan sites;
- (ii) that the maximum number of caravans to be stationed on site at any one time be 20;
and
- (iii) that the operating period for the site be limited to 4 consecutive days between 1 and 4 August 2019 to accommodate the Glamis Country Fair & Horse Trials event.
