This would raise the profile of the Forum as the local Fairtrade connection.

Community Groups: No updates

Publicity: PR reported that she had received a letter from Kirstene Hair, Montrose MP, as a follow-up to a meeting between her and Ian anad Pam in August. She had been very supportive and could certainly raise the profile of events that might happen in the future around Fair Trade.

- 6. AOCB: EF raised the question of Traidcraft's ceasing to function, and asked who there was who might possibly replace them. There is JTS (Just Trading Scotland), and the One World Shop, but these places have their own projects and are not really equipped for the volume of products. It also

raised the question of our own ability to buy stock for reselling in the town. It was felt in the end that the Fairtrade foundation or perhaps the Scottish Fair Trade Forum might be able to provide some answers.
