ANGUS COUNCIL (ALLAN STREET AND APPLGATE, ARBROATH) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2019

On 9 December 2019 Angus Council made the above noted Order which comes into operation on 31 January 2020 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Notice of the proposal to make the Order was published in The Arbroath Herald on 27 September 2019 and the effect of the Order is as advertised in said Notice.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that the Order is not within the powers conferred on by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within six weeks from today's date make an application to the Court of Session.
