PROPERTY TRANSACTION- ST MARGARET'S HOUSE, FORFAR

REPORT BY DIRECTOR OF INFRASTRUCTURE

ABSTRACT

The report seeks approval of the property transaction in relation to the former council offices at St Margaret's House, Forfar.

1. **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Committee:

- (i) approves the property transaction as detailed at **Appendix 2** and
- (ii) in accordance with Financial Regulations 17.2.3 delegate to the Director of Infrastructure to complete the transaction.

2. ALIGNMENT TO THE ANGUS LOCAL OUTCOMES IMPROVEMENT PLAN/CORPORATE PLAN

2.1 The proposal contributes to the following local outcomes contained within the Angus Local Outcomes Improvement Plan 2017-2030 and Locality Plans:

ECONOMY

- An inclusive and sustainable economy.
- Attractive employment opportunities
- Angus is a good place to live in, work and visit.

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 St Margaret's House, Orchardbank, Forfar was vacated in mid-2018 as part of the council's Agile/Estates Review. A plan of the site is included in **Appendix 1.** The area of site being leased on the plan includes approximately 72 parking spaces.
- 3.2 The property was put on the market for let in April 2019 and the offer detailed in **Appendix 2** is to be considered.
- 3.3 The running cost for the building including business rates, servicing and standing charges is currently in excess of £50,000 per annum.
- 3.4 Section 17.1 of the Council's financial regulations requires the Director of Infrastructure to submit a report for consideration where the value of a property transaction exceeds delegated authority.

4. FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1 The lease of the property will generate a significant increase in revenue for Angus Council.
- 4.2 The lease of the property will result in revenue savings in the order of £50,000 per annum.


