CARAVAN SITE LICENCE - MARDEN BARN, KILRY, BLAIRGOWRIE

REPORT BY THE DIRECTOR OF COMMUNITIES

ABSTRACT

This report deals with an application to grant a caravan site licence at Marden Barn, Kilry, PH11 8JA, in order to allow use of the land for the purposes of a caravan site for Eco Camping Pods.

1. RECOMMENDATION

1.1 It is recommended that the Committee agree:-

- (i) to grant a caravan site licence to Kay Tompkins, Marden Barn, Kilry, PH11 8JA subject to the site's compliance with the "Model Standards" for caravan sites;
- (ii) that the maximum number of Eco Camping Pods to be stationed on site at any one time be 2; and
- (iii) that the operating period for the site be all year round.

3. BACKGROUND

3.1 Angus Council recently received an application for a caravan site licence in terms of the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act 1960 from Ms Kay Tompkins, Marden Barn, Kilry, Blairgowrie. Confirmation has been received from the Planning Division that all relevant planning permissions are in place for a maximum of 2 pods, no other chalets or caravans are permitted. As part of the planning conditions, the pods are not to be occupied by the same individual or group of individuals for a period exceeding 12 weeks in any 26 week period.

4. DETERMINATION OF LICENCE

4.1. The proposed site has been inspected by Environmental Health staff and no safety or sanitation issues have been identified. The service has provided detailed information with regard to the "Model Standards" for caravan sites and a further inspection will be undertaken once the site is occupied.

4.2. On the basis that the site will meet the requirements of "Model Standards" in compliance with The Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act, 1960 and that the necessary planning consents are in place, this application should be granted.
