## 4. REVIEW OF POLICY AND RESOURCES COMMITTEE COMMUNITY ASSET TRANSFER APPLICATION DECISION – CARNOUSTIE AND MONIFIETH MEN'S SHED – THE MACHINE ROOM, INVERTAY HOUSE, 3 MAULE STREET, MONIFIETH

There was submitted Report No 416/19 by the Director of Finance detailing an application for a review of the decision taken by the Policy and Resources Committee to reject the Community Asset Transfer application by Carnoustie and Monifieth Men's Shed for The Machine Room, Invertay House, 3 Maule Street, Monifieth.

The Committee confirmed that they had sufficient information to consider the review and that no further procedure was required.

Having given careful consideration to the papers submitted by the Community Asset Transfer body and the authority, and having heard from the Director of Finance, the Committee agreed to confirm the decision of the Policy and Resources Committee of 4 April 2019 to reject the request as it was the Committee's view that the alternative use of the Invertay site for the provision of council housing provided better overall value.
