4. MOTIONS IN TERMS OF STANDING ORDER 25(1)

(i) Unadopted Roads

Councillor Moore has submitted the following motion

“This Council notes:

- Historically many properties were sold without the road being adopted. Present costs to bring roads up to adoptable standard are prohibitive for most householders.
- Angus Council has neither the resources nor the responsibility to repair unadopted roads.
- Unadopted roads within the authority's area are deteriorating, some to a state where the authority is having to consider closure

This Council asks:

- 1) the Chief Executive to write to the Scottish Government and the UK Government to seek a grant system to assist householders to meet their responsibilities;
- 2) the Chief Executive to write to the authority's MP and MSPs to discuss how this scheme could be implemented; and
- 3) the Director of Infrastructure to produce a Report detailing estimated cost per kilometre/mile to bring a road to an adoptable standard and which unadopted roads are currently a concern for continued Council service delivery."

(ii) Removal of Gull Species from SNH General Licenses

Councillor Stewart has submitted the following motion

"This Council notes the content of Report No 110/20 and in particular the decision by SNH to remove all gull species from the general licences and:

1. Asks the Chief Executive to write to SNH and COSLA with regard to the recent changes to the licensing regime which removed all gull species from the general licence;
2. Highlights the menace that seagulls cause to residents & visitors throughout our coastal towns & villages in Angus (and indeed elsewhere) being detrimental to health & safety and the wellbeing of all; and
3. Asks that an exemption to the legislation be considered for towns and villages identified as being at risk from stopping the removal of seagull nests and eggs."
