## REQUEST FOR EXERCISE OF EMERGENCY POWERS BY THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE/DIRECTORS

Particularly during the Covid-19 pandemic, you may need to take action including spending money in ways you have not required to do before. It is very important that before you do this, you ensure that you have the requisite authority.

Initially you should check the Scheme of Delegation to Officers contained within <u>Standing Orders</u> and the <u>Financial Regulations</u> for authority. Failing which, the Chief Executive and the Directors have been granted additional powers to act in an emergency which may be used see <u>Interim Scheme of Delegation</u>. If it proves necessary to use any of the emergency powers in the Interim Scheme of Delegation please complete the request form below and send it to the Chief Executive or the relevant Director. <u>Please note - the proposed action must not be taken until approval of the Chief Executive or the requisite Director is given.</u>

Background	Please provide background information explaining why the action is required and the emergency nature of the situation.	On 10 March 2020 P&R Committee approved that a Grant Agreement would be entered into with Voluntary Action Angus (VAA) and it was implied that this agreement would be signed prior to any payment being made. Unfortunately, it has not yet been possible to finalise the Grant Agreement due to both parties' focus on the Covid-19 pandemic over recent weeks.
Proposal	Please detail what action is required and how it is to be resourced (if any additional resource is required).	It is felt that in the circumstances it would be appropriate to use emergency delegated powers to authorise payment to VAA now, notwithstanding the Grant Agreement has not yet been finalised and signed. It is therefore requested that emergency powers are used to approve immediate payment of £13,245.00 to VAA. This money is the first instalment of their normal annual payment that was approved by P&R Committee on 10 March this year. It is not an additional amount.

<u>Risks</u>	Please detail any areas of risk and any mitigation being put in place.	It is intended that the Grant Agreement will be signed as soon as possible and certainly before the second instalment is due. Obviously there is always a risk in making a payment before an agreement is signed, however this arrangement has been in place for years with VAA and we have no reason to think that they would take the money and not deliver the services. Indeed, we know that they are fully involved with the Council's response to the Covid- 19 pandemic.
Financial Implications	Please provide details of any financial implications or confirm if there are none.	This money is the first instalment of their normal annual payment that was approved by P&R Committee on 10 March this year. It is not an additional amount.
