THE ANGUS COUNCIL (HOROLOGE HILL, ARBROATH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2020

Angus Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf being satisfied that traffic on the road or roads referred to in this Order should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said road or roads, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the "The Angus Council (Horologe Hill, Arbroath) (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2019" and shall come into force from 08 June 2020 from which date it is anticipated that the work will last for a period of 20 weeks, however, the maximum duration in terms of said Act is 18 months, for the purpose of relieving congestion and maintaining free traffic flow during new school construction and associated demolition works.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 hereof, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in on south side of Horologe Hill Road, Arbroath for a distance of 50 metres or thereby north westwards from the existing School Keep Clear markings and 59 metres south westwards from the existing School Keep Clear markings for Abbey View Campus.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to wait in the length of road specified in that Article if the vehicle is being used: -
 - (a) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer or drain or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus as defined in sub-paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (b) for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes or in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers and duties;
